

Precautions During Covid-19 Pandemic

To keep everyone as safe as possible and follow government guidelines, we have had to adapt our routine at pre-school and how it is organised. We have always welcomed parents/carers into our setting, but unfortunately at the moment we do not let them or any visitors into pre-school during sessions.

We have become an “outside” pre-school, holding the sessions in the garden. We have plenty of shelter either from trees or combined shed and covered decking area, which will protect us from sun, wind and rain. This will enable us to still provide an extensive range of activities and experiences. We will continue until the weather is too cold, as there is less likelihood of transmission of the virus outside.

All toys and equipment, chairs and tables, used by the children each day will either be washed at the end of the day, or put into quarantine for at least 72 hours. All soft furnishings have been removed and the carpeted area cordoned off, as these cannot be washed daily.

As part of our Covid policy we require that children only attend one childcare setting.
